

Stuart's QuickTips: Directory Submissions

Point #1

Submitting to directories is an old method of getting links. It is not well favored now, but is also useful. [You can get a copy of this very user-friendly submission software here.](#)

Point #2

Directories that matter the most are also very difficult to get in. The easiest way to get into a directory is to ensure that you have very good content.

Point #3

The human-edited directory, www.DMOZ.org is the largest and most important of its kind. Google likes those that are listed in DMOZ, but it takes anything between 3-9 months to get listed there. Being listed allows you to get indexed faster. You may simply want to submit your link and then just wait.
